Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1984

A Local Law Providing for Reduction of Per Centum of Business Investment Exemptions Granted by Section 485-B of the Real Property Tax Law to Zero in the Town of New Haven.

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of New Haven as follows:

- Section 1. This Local Law shall be known as a Local Law reducing per Centum of business investment exemptions granted by Section 485-B of the Real Property Tax Law to zero in the Town of New Haven.
- Section 2. The purpose of this Local Law is to reduce to zero the per centum of business investment exemptions granted by Section 485-B of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.
- Section 3. This Local Law is made and enacted pursuant to powers granted for the reduction of said exemptions pursuant to Section 485-B, sub-division 7 of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York.
- Section 4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
