

Section 1 This Local Law shall be known as “Local Law Prohibiting Parking on Town Roads in the Town of New Haven,” Town of New Haven, County of Oswego and State of New York.

Section 2 This Local Law is enacted for the purpose of prohibiting parking on certain streets in the Town of New Haven, County of Oswego and State of New York, in order to protect the safety, health, comfort and general welfare of the inhabitants of the Town of New Haven

Section 3 DEFINITIONS AND PROHIBITIONS

1. Highway: The entire width between the boundary lines of every way publicly maintained when any part thereof is open to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel in the Town of New Haven.
2. Parking: Means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose, and while engaged in, loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.
3. Standing: Means the stopping of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of, and while actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers.
4. Stopping: When prohibited, means any halting, even momentarily, of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, except when necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or traffic control sign or signal.
5. Vehicle: Every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, or waterway, including devices moved by human power.
6. Highway Superintendent: The duly elected Highway Superintendent for the Town of New Haven, County of Oswego, State of New York.

Section 4 PROHIBITION

- (a) Vehicular parking is hereby prohibited on all Town Roads located in the Town of New Haven.
- (b) The storage, placement, or parking of unregistered or unlicensed vehicles is hereby prohibited on all Town roads within the Town of New Haven.

Section 5 ENFORCEMENT

The Town Highway Superintendent is authorized to initiate any necessary action in Local Town Court in the enforcement of this local law. In doing so, the Town Highway Superintendent may rely upon the Town Attorney for preparation of any and all necessary documents as required for said enforcement action.

Section 6      PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION

- (a) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, a violation of the provisions hereof, shall constitute a traffic infraction, and shall subject the violator to a fine of not more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars.
- (b) The Town Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized to enforce this law by commencing an action, including but not limited to injunctive relief in any court of competent jurisdiction including the New York State Supreme Court, and/or an action in local Town Court pursuant to a simplified information or accusatory instrument.
- (c) The Town Highway Superintendent is hereby authorized to remove any vehicle found in violation of the provisions hereof, at the Town's expense, but that said expense shall be levied against the property taxes of the violator if said violator is found to own properties in the Town of New Haven, after the violation has been found to exist by a Court of competent jurisdiction.
