- 1- Circle T's site map shows a grassy area on the northeastern end of the site's high elevation. However, as you drive by, or as shown in pictures, we see cement trucks are parked there. So if parking areas, that make noise (idling vehicles, back-up beepers, etc), aren't shown correctly, what else is incorrect on the site?
- 2- Note that, "nuisance noises" that are most disturbing, occur BEFORE & AFTER the "normal business hours". Noises 91ch as: Tailgate slams, Jack Hammering, banging out towers, the heater sounds, etc.
- 3- New Haven's local law #2 section 5.10, talks about the noise that we, the neighbors, aren't supposed to be hearing. We do hear these noises outside the site's border. We hear noises outside and, most importantly, inside our homes.

Circle T, the Town and the Oswego County Supreme Court agreed to an indepth noise study. It was to be done within 12 months. However, a year plus past the agreed time frame, a sound **survey** was done; and not even on a busy day. This, we believe, skewed the results.

We ask the planning board to uphold the local laws for, the preservation of the every day lives of the residents that live near this batch plant.
