



# 2025 Oswego County RABIES CLINICS



*Suggested donation \$7.00 per pet*

- All Rabies Clinics are by appointment **ONLY** on Wednesday evenings from 6 to 8pm
- Appointments will be scheduled clinic by clinic, with lines opening the Wednesday prior
- If you are unable to keep your appointment for any reason, please call to cancel it.
- All pets must be at least 3 months of age. Pets receiving their first rabies shot must get a booster within 1 year.
- All pets must be restrained on a leash or in a pet carrier.
- Proof of previous vaccination is required to qualify for a three-year certificate. Accepted forms of proof:
  - (a) "Certificate of Vaccination" obtained from veterinarian or Oswego County Environmental Division or
  - (b) "Dog license" showing rabies expiration date.
