## Town of New Haven Regulations of Water District #8

At a regular meeting of the New Haven Town Board held November 20, 2018, the following rules, regulations and schedule of rates were duly passed and adopted for enforcing the collection of water rents and regulating the use of municipal water for Water District #8.

- 1. All water rents shall be chargeable and assessed against the property owners and such rents shall be due and payable within 30 days of date of billing without penalty. After that date 10% late charge will be added. After 60 days from date of Billing water will be shut off by the Village of Mexico, for any unpaid bills. A charge of \$50.00 payable in advance will be made to restore usage. For reconnects that will occur after 2:00 pm, or on a weekend or holiday, there will be an additional \$100.00 fee to cover overtime. Said fee shall be paid to the Town of New Haven. The Town of New Haven shall pay these fees to the Village of Mexico with the next regular water billing.
- 2. The base quarterly charge for water usage shall be equivalent to the cost for 5,000 gallons of water plus a \$15 operations and maintenance fee for the first 5,000 gallons used. Additional water usage will be charged at the then current rate per 1,000 gallons, charged by the Village of Mexico.
- 3. All water charges remaining due and unpaid at the time of the annual tax roll of the Town of New Haven shall be included therein and levied against the real property for which same charges were made.
- 4. All applications for the introduction of or use of water on any premises, or for the extension of any water pipe, shall be in writing, and signed by the owner of such premises or by his duly authorized agent; and must fully and truly state the purposes for which such water is required; and all the expenses incident to the introduction or use of water on any premises, must be paid by the applicant, at the time of signing the application.
- 5. No addition to or alteration in any public or private pipe, conduit, or other fixtures between the public water main and the individual water meter shall be made by any person, nor shall the water main be tapped, or any other portion of the water works system interfered with, without the permission in writing, of the Superintendent, nor shall any person open or interfere with any public hydrant without permission of the Superintendent, the Board of Water Commissioners or the Chief of the Fire Department, or some other person duly authorized by such authority.
